

Multiplication Rhymes

10 *Five pennies make a nickel; Two nickels make a dime. ($5 \times 1 = 5$; $2 \times 5 = 10$)*

100 *Ten dimes make a dollar; That's a hundred pennies in all. ($10 \times 10 = 100$)*

25 *Five pennies make a nickel; Five nickels make a quarter. ($5 \times 1 = 5$; $5 \times 5 = 25$)*

100 *Four quarters make a dollar; That's a hundred pennies in all. ($4 \times 25 = 100$)*

16 *Do you want to drive a **4 by 4** truck? Unless you're **16**, you're **OUT** of luck! $4 \times 4 = 16$.*

18 The **two** frankenstein monsters **ate teens**. $2 \times 9 = 18$.

18 These **three** stinky trolls chewed **six** garlic cloves whenever they **ate beans**. $3 \times 6 = 18$.

21 In just **3 weeks** we'll have **plenty of fun**; $3 \times 7 = 21$.

24 A **tree** on **skates** fell to the **floor**, 3×8 is 24.

24 **More tricks? Plenty more!** 4×6 is 24.

24 On these **two shelves** there is **plenty** I **adore**. 2×12 is 24.

27 A **divine treat** is **plenty** of manna from **heaven**. 9×3 is 27.

27 **Behind** the **tree** we spied a **teeny sovereign**. $9 \times 3 = 27$.

28 This time we *fished* **before seven** with **plenty** of **bait**. $4 \times 7 = 28$.

32 I **ate** **before**. NOW I'm **thirsty, too**. $8 \times 4 = 32$.

35 *7 and 5 went for a drive. Who's in the backseat? 35!* $7 \times 5 = 35$.

36 6×6 , *Magic tricks! Abracadabra 36!* $6 \times 6 = 36$.

36 The second little pig reasoned, "I'll use **more twine** to make my house of **sturdy sticks**." $4 \times 9 = 36$.

36 **That shelf** has **three** cans of ginger ale if you get **thirsty** and **sick**. $12 \times 3 = 36$.

42 In **6 weeks** I'll have **more** than a **clue**; 6×7 is 42.

48 *6 and 8 bake a cake. They make number 48!* $6 \times 8 = 48$.

48 **Four elves** cooked for Santa **for he** had lost **weight**. $4 \times 12 = 48$.

49 In **seventh heaven** I saw a **porcupine**. 7×7 is 49.

54 The third little pig rejoiced, "Making **mine** with **bricks** was a **nifty chore!**" 9×6 is 54.

56 **Stephen** ate lunch with a **thrifty chick**. 7×8 is 56.

60 **Twelve hives** made honey. Wow, it's **sticky!** 12×5 has to "bee" 60. ($12 \times 5 = 60$)

63 **Kevin whined** by a **prickly tree**. He whined about learning $7 \times 9 = 63$.

Now **Kevin whines** 'cause the **prickles** didn't let him **be!**

64 I **ate** and I **ate** and got **sick** on the **floor**, 8×8 is 64.

72 At **8** we **dined** on a **heavenly stew**. 8×9 is 72.

72 **Six shelves** in the parlor looked **heavenly, too**. $6 \times 12 = 72$.

81 He **dined** in **line** and **ate** a **ton**, 9×9 is 81.

84 At the gingerbread house, **Devin the elf** ate the **decor**; $7 \times 12 = 84$

96 The boy **ate** everything on **the shelf**, then he felt **naughty** and **sick**, 8×12 is 96.

108 I **lined the shelves**, I got **hungry and ate**. $9 \times 12 = 108$.

121 **Eleven elephants** were **hunted** with **plenty** of **guns**; Let's protect them from poachers. $11 \times 11 = 121$.

132 Building **11 shelves** made me **hungry and thirsty, too**. $11 \times 12 = 132$

144 **Twelve shelves** of books, a **hundred or more**; 12×12 is one hundred forty-four.
